

WHAT TO ASK YOUR ELECTION CANDIDATES

Ask these questions when they knock on your door or telephone you, or write to them directly.

I back the Vision of the Friends of Carlisle Victorian and Turkish Baths for Carlisle's historic public baths on James Street, and this is one of the issues that will determine how I vote in the May elections.

Keeping the Turkish Baths in operation and achieving the Vision will need you - if you are elected - to do four things and I would like you to answer these questions:

1. Will you press City Council officers to ensure arrangements are in place so that the Turkish Baths remain in operation after the new pools at The Sands Centre open, up until demolition of the 1974 pool extension takes place?
2. Will you support a Community Asset Transfer of the James Street Public Baths to the Friends?
3. Will you support developing the Public Baths as a Centre for Health and Wellbeing and will you reject proposals to develop the building as a retail, events, conference space, nightclub, or bistro?
4. Will you arrange to meet with the Friends to discuss the Vision? If you have met with them in the last six months, please let me know when the meeting took place.
